

Remote Audit of Elevators in Japan Using Vuzix M400™ Smart Glasses

Fujitec Co., Ltd. ("Fujitec"), the world's largest manufacturer of elevators, escalators, and moving walkways, has commenced a full-scale deployment of Vuzix M400 smart glasses, after conducting proof-of-concept (PoC) studies using smart glasses for several years, to support engineers in the areas of elevator maintenance and training in Japan.

Challenge

There is a critical need to pass on knowledge and skills to a younger generation of service engineers. Fujitec recognized the challenge of providing optimal elevator and escalator maintenance given the sophistication of their products and the knowledge and maintenance required to service such, as well as dealing with an aging workforce. To combat these challenges, Fujitec turned to Vuzix M400 smart glasses to complete remote audits, hands-free, and offer real-time remote support to junior engineers in the field.
